State of Iowa, Madison County. ss, I, W. G. Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than sixty years last past, and that for many years I lived south of Winterset, and was familiar with the lands and their ownership forty and fifty years ago; that I remember of Isaac Stouder owning land south west of Winterset, Iowa, being land which John W. Wilson afterwards owned; that said Isaac Stouder as I remember was not an actual resident of the County, but was here to look after his land; that from my recollection of the parties, and according to my best information and belief Isaac Stouder as his name appears in a conveyance from Jacob F. Fox of the South fractional half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of section nineteen (19) in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the 5th P. M., Iowa, was in fact Isaac Stouder, who afterwards conveyed the same to John Stouder; that I have no recollection of any person named Stouder owning said land or any other land in that neighborhood at or near that time, but I do remember the Stouders, and that as I believe Isaac Stouder and Isaac Stouder was one and the same man,
