Gordon who died testate on the 6th day of June 1905 and I well and personally know that the said Joel D. Gordon at that time left no widow surviving him, his wife having died prior to the 6th of June, 1905, and that the said Joel D. Gordon and J.D. Gordon are one and the same person.

I further depose and say that Gerena J. Gordon, Jennie Gordon, and Miss S.J. Gordon are one and the same person.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Henry L. McCarty who conveyed to Rhoda McCarty by warranty deed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 20, Twp 76, Range 26, said deed being dated January 20, 1868 and recorded in Deed Record V page 174 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and I well and personally know that at the date of the execution of said deed Henry L. McCarty was a single and unmarried man.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Rhoda McCarty who executed a warranty deed to H.L. McCarty to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20, Twp 76 Range 26, Madison County, Iowa, said deed being dated December 31, 1872 and recorded in Deed Record 8 page 552 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that on the date of the execution of the aforesaid deed the said Rhoda McCarty was a single and unmarried woman.
