State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, J.C. Foster, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for sixty years last past; that I am a son of Moses Foster who on or about June 26th, 1855, purchased the north west fractional quarter (4) of Section one (1) in township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, from Andrew Simon and wife Sarah Simon or Andrew Simons and wife Sarah Simons; that I am unable to state whether the last name of the grantors from whom my father purchased said land was Simon or Simons, but that the Sarah Simon ^{Sarah} or, Simons who joined in the deed was the same person as Sarah Simon who entered said land and to whom the same was patented. In other words the person from whom my father purchased said land was the person who entered said land and to whom it was patented.
