Young, dated May 24th, 1910, recorded in Deed Record 52, page 31 of the records of Madison county, Iowa, conveying the South 5 acres of W $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  & NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  & NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14, Twp. 74, N., Rng. 26, West 5th P.M., except one half acre out of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  for grave yard, on my oath depose and say that the mortgage of \$1850.00 mentioned in said conveyance, refers to a certain mortgage executed by C.H. Young to Iowa State Bank for \$1850.00, dated March 23rd, 1904, recorded on page 443 of Mortgage Record 41 of the records of said county, and covering the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  & NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section, township and range.

That said mortgage was paid off by me in December of the year 1911, and the release thereof is recorded on page 474 of Mortgage Record 53 of the records of said county, and that is the release delivered for record at the time of my making payment of said mortgage. That affiant is not able to state why said release is dated July 15th, 1905, but does state, it to be the fact that said mortgage was not paid off by him until about the first day of December 1911, and that said mortgage was not paid at the time of the conveyance above referred to and payment of the same was assumed by this affiant in said conveyance.
