State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, W.L. Smalley of said County and State, on oath say that I wrote a certain deed from Martha Utter and Others, the widow and heirs at law of John Ogburn, deceased, conveying to Rufus Walker the south west quarter of the north east quarter of section twenty nine, in township seventy four north, of range twenty six, west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, dated on or about November 27th, 1900, and recorded in deed record 31 of said County, at page 571 thereof; that in drawing said deed we were informed that the name of the husband of Mary E. Shutt was Kager Shutt, as he was commonly called, but afterwards learning that his correct name was Micajah Shutt, we corrected the name from Kager to Micajah in the granting clause of the deed, but overlooked making the correction in the clause releasing dower, but that in said deed Kager Shutt and Micajah Shutt refer to one and the same man, Kager being the name commonly applied to him, and Micajah being his correct name.
