Clark of said County and State on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past, and that for about forty years I have been acquainted with the ownership and possession of the Southwest quarter (4) of Section fifteen (15), township seventy-seven (77) north, ex range twenty-seven (27) west 5th P.M. Iowa, and that for twenty five years or more I have lived near said land, and during that time have been assessor of said township four years. That I remember of Ferdinand Marquardt buying said land thirty or more years ago and know of him farming said land continuously until he sold it to W.A. Doak twenty or more years ago, and that I know W.A. Doak lived on and occupied said land from the time he bought it until his death in 1903, and that Conrad Funderger lived on and occupied the north west quarter of said south west quarter of said section from the time he purchased it from the assignees of W.A. Doak until his death in 1903, and that from that time William Funderger and Otto Funderger sons of Conrad Funderger have lived on and occupied said land, and during all that time there has never been any question made as to the title of the above named owner of said land, and no one else has ever asserted any right thereto, so far as I ever heard.
