Steele, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a cousin of David Steele, Jr., now long since deceased, to whom Joseph Hill and wife, Lueretia A. Hill, executed a certain mortgage for \$675 on the North Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (4) of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., dated August 25th 1893, and recorded in Mortgage Record 19, page 111, and was the agent for said David Steele, Jr., in negotiating said loan, and know of my personal knowledge that the above sum of \$675 was the only money the said Joseph Hill ever borrowed of the said David Steele, Jr., and that the above described mortgage securing said sum was fully paid and satisfied by the execution by the said Joseph Hill and wife to the said David Steele, Jr., of a mortgage, on above described land, for \$605, being balance due on the mortgage first herein mentioned, said last described mortgage being of date August 12th 1895, and recorded in Mortgage Record 30, page 412, but through oversight no release of said mortgage recorded in Mortgage Record 19, page 111, was ever executed and filed by the said David Steele, Jr.

All the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
