I, B.F.Bowlsby being first duly sworn on oath do depose and say:- That is was well and personally acquainted with Hugh James Lorimer and John Lorimer who appear of record as grantees in a deed from Lewis Harley and wife Elizabeth J. Harley, dated June, 2, 1857, which said deed is recorded in Deed Record "H" on page 13 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, said Hugh James Lorimer's name appearing in said deed as "H.J. Lorimer: and that the same Hugh James Lorimer deeded his interest to John Lorimer in a deed dated July, 23, 1857, and recorded in Deed Record "H" on page 110 of the records of Madison County, Iowa: and that wherever the name H.J.
