Thomson, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have been a continuous resident of Earlham, Iowa, since Mar 4, 1869 and that I was personally acquainted with Charles Foglesong, Grantor in a certain Warranty Deed dated December 29, 1871, said deed being recorded in Madison County Record Book 6, page 248, conveying the Southwest Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of the Southeast Quarter (SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Fifteen-77-28, and other land, and that the Charles Foglesong is one and the same party as Chas Fogleson Grantee in certain Warranty deed dated December 2, 1869, recorded in Madison County Record Book 2, page 385, conveying the land above described. I knew this party when he lived in this section and remember him owning this particular farm.
