State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, John B. Anderson of said County and State, being first duly sworn, depose and say,- That George T. Clements died intestate on or about August 29th, 1900.

I further state that I knew of my own personal knowledge that the Chalmers O. Clements named in the Registry of Heirs filed in the Estate of said George T. Clements was the same and identical person as the C.O. Clements, who, together with his wife, Oru C., executed a certain Quit Claim Deed wherein Grant Clements was Grantee, dated July 30, 1901 and recorded in Deed Record 39, page 165 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the South Half of the Northeast Quarter and the East half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, in Township 77, Range 27, Madison County, Iowa.

That the Lizzie Burke named in said Registry of Heirs was the same and identical person as the Elizabeth A. Burke, who, together with her husband, George H., executed a certain Quit Claim Deed to said Grant Clements, dated February 27, 1901 and recorded in Deed Record 39, page 150 of said Records and conveying the above described land.

Herten and Marion Herten named in said Registry of Heirs are the same and identical persons, respectively, as the Emily Blanche Herten or Emily Blanche Herten, Harry Glen Herten or Harry Glenn Herten and Charles Marion Herten named in a certain Petition for authority to sell Real Estate, filed September
