I, G.H.Orr, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 36 years last past; that I now own and have owned 160 acres of land joining the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 31- Twp. 75, R. 27 on the South since the year 1881.

That I was well and personally acquainted with John Ferguson, Sr., who died testate in the year 1882, and I know that the Edy and Joseph Neal, two of the devisees named in the Will of said John Ferguson, Sr., are the same and identical persons as Edwin E. Neil and Joseph H. Neil, who were the grantors in a certain Quit Claim Deed, dated February 11, 1896 and recorded in Deed Record 29, page 150 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31-75-27, and other land.
