State of Iowa, Union County, ss. I, Frank Lecocq, of said County and State, being first duly sworn depose and say: That I am a son of William H.P. Lecocq (or W.H.P. Lecocq), who on Jan. 3, 1883 obtained title to certain land in Section 14, Twp. 74 Range 28, Madison County, Iowa, by Warranty Deed from John Bancroft and wife, which deed was filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, March 24, 1883, and recorded in Deed Record 23 at Page 10; That by error, on the part of the scrivener or the recorder, the name of my father, <sup>appears</sup> therein as Wm. H.P. Lecroeq; That my father William H.P. Lecocq, died intestate on or about March 2nd, 1892 leaving surviving him, his wife Mary H.P. Lecocq, who is the same and identical person as Mary H.P. Beardsley, grantor in a certain Warranty Deed to R.W. Adcock, dated April 1, 1904, and filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, April 2, 1904, and recorded in Deed Record 45 Page 632, and as his sole and only heirs at law the following named parties, to-wit:- L.A. Lecocq, <sup>W.H.P. Lecocq</sup> Lewis J. Lecocq, Elma J. (or Janie) Lecocq, Louisa Barrett (formerly Louisa Lecocq), George Lecocq, Frank Lecocq and Viola Bancroft (Formerly Viola Lecocq) and that he left no other children, no adopted children and no children of any deceased child and that all the heirs at law of my father W.H.P. Lecocq joined in the Quit Claim Deed to Mary H.P. Lecocq, dated Feb. 21, 1896, filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, Oct. 3, 1900 and recorded in Deed Record 34 at Page 354.

I further state that the estate of my father, the said William H.P. Lecocq (or W.H.P. Lecocq) was never probated in any Court of record, but that said estate was settled many years ago and all debts and claims against the same have been paid in full.
