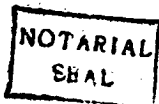
State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, W.G. Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a continuous resident of said County and State for more than sixty years last past; that I was personally acquainted with J.C. Gilliam who entered the west half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of section sixteen (16), in township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the 5th P.M. Iowa; that he was a nephew of mine by marriage, his wife being a daughter of my brother; that he and his wife separated, and he left Madison County; that his full name was James C. Gilliam, under which name his estate was settled and that he was the same person as James C. Gilliam against whom M. Glazebrook, school fund commissioner of Madison County, Iowa, foreclosed a contract for the purchase of the land above described; that I was well acquainted with Charles D. Bevington the grantee in a conveyance of said land made by the Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, on or about July 5th, 1858, and that he was the same and identical man as the Charles D. Bevington to whom the same was patented by the State, and was the same and identical man as the C. D. Bevington who on or about April 2, 1864, conveyed the south east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township and range to A. W. Larrimore; that said grantee A. W. Larrimore was the same and identical man as the A. W. Lorimor who on or about October 20, 1869, conveyed the same to Joseph Roe; that J. C. Roe to whom Joseph Roe and wife conveyed said land on or about July 8, 1875, was the same and identical man as John C. Roe who on or about November 29, 1879, conveyed the same to Joseph Roe; that Joseph A. Roe to whom Joseph Roe conveyed said land on or about March 31, 1883, was the same man as J. A. Roe who on or about August 30, 1883, conveyed the same tract to Thomas S. Graham; that S. B. Wheelock to whom the Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa on or about April 26, 1886, conveyed said tract was the same and identical man as Solomon B. Wheelock who conveyed the same tract to W. C. Newlon on or about June 15, 1892.

That I was acquainted with Jeremiah Shearer who on or about Aug. 10, 1910 conveyed a portion of said tract to A. T. Guthrie and that he was the same person as Jerry Sherarer to whom A. W. Lorimor conveyed the same.

That I have personally known all of the parties referred to herein, and am not interested in the subject matter of this affidavit except to make the facts stated matters of record.
