/ That I am the owner of the East fractional half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North-East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section one (1), Township Seventy seven (77) Range twenty six (26) in Madison County, Iowa and have owned said Real Estate since February 16th, 1893.

That I have paid all personal taxes assessed to me that the personal taxes shown of record as being unpaid for the years 1891 and 1892 should not be assessed against me, but as the County records shew against a William Miller who at one time lived on land in Section five (5) road district two (2), while my land is in Section one (1) and road district one (1)

That William Miller referred to in assessment would according to the County records now be 56 years old, while I am 49 years of age.
