Know all men by these presents: That I, Margaret H. White, unmarried, of Baltimore City in the state of Maryland, widow of Miles White, late of Baltimore City, deceased, did heretofore execute an ante-nuptial contract with the said Miles White, under which for good and valuable consideration, I did forever release and discharge all the property whatsoever owned by said Miles White, in his life time and at his death from all claims and demand whatsoever on my part for dower and thirds as his wife and widow. And I did also acquire and receive gifts and requests under the last Will and Testament of the said Miles White as by the same will appears so that I have not now and never did have at any time any claim whatever by way of dower or thirds, as wife or widow against the property or estate of the said Miles White nor thereafter in consideration of the premises and furthermore of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid and for the purposes of fully releasing all doubts and questions which could possibly arise as to any dowers and thirds I do hereby release, discharge and quit claim absolutely all my said dower and thirds and interest, and estate of every description as wife and widow in all the lands and property of the said Miles White, owned by him in his life time and at his death in the State of Maryland and in every other state of the United States wherever the same may be situated, unto the parties holding title thereto under the said Miles White, according to their respective interest therein.
