This agreement made this twenty ninth day of May 1916.

witnesseth as follows: That Henry Morris and J.E.Hamilton have this day made the following agreement for the division of the fence on the line separating their respective tracts of land being the line on the south side of the S.E. quarter of N.E. quarter of Sec. 23, and the S.W. quarter of S.W. quarter of Sec. 24 all in township 75 North, Range 28 west of 5th P.M., Henry Morris will build and maintain the west half of said partition fence and J.E. Hamilton the east half thereof, the dividing point to be the post that has here-to-fore, *between Henry Morris & has the ridge* been the division point between such posts that are now standing in the portion of the east half of said fence that was formally maintained by him, such posts to be removed by J.E. Hamilton.

J.E.Hamilton is to clean out the fence row on the west half that he here-to-fore maintained, J.E.Hamilton further agrees to pay Henry Morris (\$15.00) fifteen dollars/
