Smith, who obtained title to the West Three-fourths of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 74, Range 26, Madison County, Iowa, by deed, dated Nov. 27, 1899, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, in Deed Record 41, page 220, and the same identical person as the J.M. Smith who obtained title to the East one-fourth of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 74, Range 26, Madison County, Iowa, by Warranty Deed, dated August 24, 1898, and recorded in said Office in Deed Record 38, page 308, and the same and identical person as J.M. Smith one of the Grantors in a certain Warranty Deed, dated Feb. 25, 1907, and recorded in Deed Record 46, page 215 of the Records of said County and State.

I further state that I now live in Newton County, Missouri, but that I formerly lived in Scott Township and Ohio Township in Madison County, Iowa, but that I never lived or had any property subject to taxation in Walnut Township, Madison County, Iowa, and that no taxes were ever assessed against me in said Walnut Township, Madison County, Iowa; that the taxes of 1899 for \$2.88 assessed against J.M. Smith of Walnut Township and the taxes of 1901 for \$4.60 assessed against James M. Smith of Walnut Township are not against this affiant.
