I, Stephen Steel of said County and State, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the same identical person as the Stephen Steel, who, on August 16, 1910, made and executed an Affidavit, which was filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, August 18, 1910, and duly recorded in Miscellaneous Record 17, page 399, wherein I stated that Franklin C. Palston, Grantee of David W. Ralston (appearing David W. Ralston) and wife, Catharine R., in a conveyance of said real estate, dated on or about October 1, 1873, "was the same and identical person as the Frank C. Ralston named in the Registry of Heirs of said David W. Palston" and who was a party to the suit for partition of said real estate in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, and that said statement was erroneous, and that there never was a suit for partition had in connection with the Estate of David W. Ralston, but that it was my intention that said Affidavit should recite that said Franklin C. Palston was the same and identical person as the Frank C. Ralston named in the Registry of Heirs of the said David W. Ralston, and as the Franklin C., or Frank C. Ralston named in the proceedings brought by the Administrators of the Estate of D. W. Ralston, Deceased, to sell the land for the payment of the debts of said Decedent.

I further state that I am in no way interested in making this Affidavit or in the title to the land therein described, but make the same for the purpose of correcting the error made in the Affidavit above described.
