I, J.M.Douglas, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with William Farson, who entered the West Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Southwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 8-74-26, containing 120 acres, and with his widow and heirs at law;

That said William Farson died intestate on or about March 3, 1863, leaving Susan C. Farson as his widow, and the following named parties as his sole and only heirs at law; Mary Farson John H. Farson, Angeline Farson, Atwell V. Farson, Emily E. Farson, or Emely E. Farson as her name appears in the Registry of Heirs of said William Farson, deceased, and Rebecca Farson;

That Susan C. Farson, grantee in a certain quit claim deed dated July 29, 1864, filed for record October 1, 1864 and recorded in Deed Record "O", page 208 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, was the widow of said William Farson; and that Mary Fulton, who together with her husband, William Fulton, signed said deed, was the same and identical person as the Mary Farson named in the Registry of Heirs filed in said estate;

That John H. Farson and Susan Farson, two of the grantors in said deed, were husband and wife at the date thereof, and that said John H. Farson was the same and identical person as the John H. Farson named in the Registry of Heirs; that if the name of the wife of said John H. Farson appears in said deed as Suseann Farson or Susann Farson, it is only by reason of error or mistake, as her correct name was Susan Farson;

That Angeline Rollings, one of the grantors in said deed was the same and identical person as the Angeline Farson named in said Registry of Heirs, she having intermarried with one Caleb Rollins, and if her name appears in said deed as Angeline Rollings or Anglin Rollins, it is a mistake and should have been Angeline Rollins;

That Atwell V. Farson, one of the grantors in said deed is the same and identical person as the Atwell V. Farson named in said Registry of Heirs; and if his name appears in the body of said deed as Attwell V. Farson, the same is a mistake, as his true and correct name is Atwell V. Farson;

That Eliza A. Farson, or Eliza Anne Farson, who joined in said deed, was the wife of said Atwell V. Farson at the date of the execution of said deed;

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That Emily E. Delong, one of the grantors named in said deed was the same and identical person as the Emily E. Parson named in the Registry of Heirs; and if her name appears in the Certificate of Acknowledgment; of said deed as Emily Delong, it is only through error, as her full, true and correct name is Emily E. Delong;

That Joseph H. M. Delong who joined in said deed was the husband of said Emily E. Delong at the date of the execution thereof; and that Rebecca Parson, one of the grantors in said deed, was the same and identical person as the Rebecca Parson named in said Registry of Heirs.

I further state that I am in no way interested in the making of this Affidavit nor in the title to the land herein described, but make the same for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
