State of Iowa, Madison County, ss. I, S.M. Hamilton, of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John Musselman during his lifetime.

I further state that John Musselman, the grantee in a certain Warranty Deed, dated April 17, 1876, filed for record April 25, 1876, and recorded in Deed Record 13 page 83 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa; John Mussulman, one of the Grantees in a certain Warranty Deed, dated February 14, 1890, filed for record March 24, 1890, and recorded in Deed Record 27, page 632 of said Records; and John Muselman, who, together with his wife, Frances Muselman, were Grantors in a certain Warranty Deed, Dated November 2, 1908, filed for record November 7, 1908, and recorded in Deed Record 46, page 295, is one and the same identical person, his true and correct name being John Muselman, and wherever the name John Musselman, John Muselman, and John Mussulman appear in connection with the title to any part of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township Seventy-four (74) Range Twenty-six (26), Madison County, Iowa, it refers to and is one and the same identical person; namely John Muselman.

I further state that the Frances Muselman who joined in said deed recorded in Deed Record 46, page 295, was the wife of the said John Muselman on February 14, 1890.

I further state that I am in no way interested in the making of this Affidavit nor in the title to the land herein described, but make the same for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
