I, J.H.Cochran, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with J.C.Grandfield who died in Madison County, Iowa, about May 9<sup>th</sup> 1896 and the Probate Proceedings in whose estate are shown in Probate Docket "D", page 244, and with the members of his family, and know that the Elizabeth Grandfield named as widow in the Registry of Heirs filed in said estate was the same and identical person as the Elizabeth Grandfield, the Probate Proceedings in whose estate are shown in Probate Docket "D", page 382, and as the Elizabeth Grandfield who was plaintiff in a certain Partition Action shown in Appearance Docket "Q", page 62.

I further depose and say that the Alice E.Stearns, Rosa M.Porter, Ada L.Logsdon, Joseph M.Grandfield, John W.Grandfield, Oscar M.Grandfield, Oliver A.Grandfield, and Fred W.Grandfield named in the Registry of Heirs filed in the estate of said J.C.Grandfield were the same and identical persons respectively as the Alice E.Stearns, Rosa M.Porter, Addie L.Logsdon, Joseph M.Grandfield, John W.Grandfield, Oscar M.Grandfield, Oliver A.Grandfield and Fred W.Grandfield named in the Registry of Heirs filed in the estate of the said Elizabeth Grandfield, and also as the Alice E.Stearns, Rosa Porter, Ada L.Logsdon, or Addie Logsdon, J.M.Grandfield, J.W.Grandfield, O.M.Grandfield, O.A.Grandfield and F.W.Grandfield named as defendants in said Partition Action; that the above named Rosa M.Porter and Oscar M.Grandfield were the same and identical persons respectively as the Rosa Porter and O.M. Grandfield who joined in conveying their interests in Lots 106, 107, 108 and 109 in Block 9 of Macks Addition to Macksburg, Iowa, to C.C.Logsdon by deed dated January 11<sup>th</sup> 1900 and recorded in Deed Record 39, page 136; that the above named Fred W.Grandfield and Oliver A.Grandfield were the same and identical persons respectively as the Fred Grandfield and O.A.Grandfield who joined in conveying their interests in above described lots to J.M.Grandfield by deed dated January 11<sup>th</sup> 1901 and recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 13, page 23; that the above named John W. Grandfield was the same and identical person as the John William Grandfield or J.W.Grandfield for whom J.M.Grandfield was appointed guardian as shown by Guardianship Docket "C", page 195; and that the Frank Stearns named as one of the defendants in above named Partition Action was the same and identical person as the Frank E.Stearns who accepted service of notice in said action; all the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
