That he was the same and identical person as the Samuel B. Casbeer who with his wife Nancy conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 17-75-27 and other real estate by Warranty Deed dated Oct. 24th, 1853 to Josiah James, and the same and identical person as the Samuel B. Cashier named in the acknowledgement to the last described deed, which is recorded in Deed Record A, page 432 of the records of said County;
