State of Iowa, Madison County. ss. I, A.W. Wilkinson of said County and State being sworn on oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with David P. Clapp in 1874 & 1875. That in the year 1875 I was engaged in the practice of law in Winterset, Iowa and did some legal business for said David P. Clapp. That the D.P. Clapp who is mentioned as one of the grantees in a deed dated July 30th A.D. 1874 and recorded in town lot deed record 2 on page 68 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and the D.P. Clapp and the Daniel P. Clapp named as one of the grantors in a deed dated June 19th A.D. 1875, recorded in town lot deed record 1 on page 275, of the said records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying to J.J. Hutchings lots 3 & 4 in Block 21 of West Addition to Winterset, Iowa, are one and the same identical person and his true name was David P. Clapp. That I wrote and acknowledged the last named deed and personally know that it was executed by said David P. Clapp.

That while I once owned said property I now have no interest therein, and simply make this affidavit for the purpose of correcting what appears to be discrepancies in some of the deeds to said real estate.
