Jones of said County and State, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 50 years last past; and that I am well and personally acquainted with the Emma Jane (Jones) Ross, who acquired title to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12-75-27, by Warranty Deed, dated June 28, 1878 and recorded in Deed Record 16, page 337 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa; and that she is the same and identical person as the Emma Ross, who together with her husband, John D., conveyed the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ except one-half acre, more or less, in the N.E. corner thereof for school purposes, of Sec. 11; the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, in Twp. 75, Range 27; and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Twp. 75, Range 26, West of the 5th P.M.
