State of Iowa; Madison County, ss. I, Eugene Wilson, being first duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that J. M. Wilson, who is mentioned as holding a certain mortgage said mention being made in a deed wherein P. T. Youngs is grantor and S. A. Youngs is grantee dated October 31st 1893 and recorded in Deed Record 33 page 272 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying West Half of South West Quarter (SW¹) of Section 32, Township 74 North, Range 29 West of the 5th P.M.; is dead and that I am his son and was administrator in the settlement of his estate and that I have personal knowledge relative to the said mortgage and that I know that the said mortgage was never recorded and I further know that the said mortgage was paid in full and that it is not a lien on the said land at the present time, that the makers of the said mortgage are dead and that when it was paid the said mortgage was delivered to the parties paying the same and that it is either lost or destroyed and that it can not be found at the present time and it is impossible to record it now.
