State of Iowa, Madison County, ss, I, W.G.Dorrell, on oath say that I have been continuously a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than sixty years last past; that I was acquainted with Francis Cassidy, (commonly known as Frank Cassidy) at one time having dug a well on his farm, who on or about March 5, 1870, conveyed unto John Harrington the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the south half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), all in section twenty three (23) in township seventy six (76) north, of range twenty six (26) west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, and that he was the same and identical man as Francis Cassidy to whom John B. Rose and wife on or about August 2nd, 1856, conveyed the south half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section, township, and range, and was the same person as Francis Cassidy to whom Jesse Goodrich and wife on or about November 24th, 1863, conveyed the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section, township, and range, and was the same and identical person as Francis Cassidy to whom Benjamin F. Allen and wife on or about January 31, 1856, conveyed the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section, township, and range, and was the same person as Francis Cassidy to whom Patrick Smith and wife on or about April 22nd, 1859, conveyed the south half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said section, township, and range by quit claim deed. In other words Francis Cassidy, Francis Cassiday, Francis Cassady, and Francis Cassidy, was one and the same man, as I verily believe.
