Landers of said state and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Benjamin Bishop who on March 16th, 1861 executed a deed conveying the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  11-75-27 to John Landers, said deed being filed for record in Madison county, Iowa, on March 16th, 1861 and recorded on page 17 of Deed Record M and I well and personally know that on said date the said Benjamin Bishop was an unmarried man, and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Rebecca Bishop on March 16th, 1861 and I well and personally know that on said date she was a widow, she having never remarried after the death of her husband Levi Bishop, and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Claiborn Bishop who was one of the devisees in the will of Levi Bishop, deceased, and I well and personally know that he is the same and identical person as Clayborn Bishop who was the defendant in a certain action in the county court of Madison county, Iowa, wherein Rebecca Bishop, guardian of said Clayborn Bishop was plaintiff, said action being brought by said guardian for the sale of the interest of her said ward in the W $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  11-75-27.
