State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, E. Jones, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously since the year 1865 and that there never was a meeting house or place of worship built or used upon the following described tract of land: Commencing at a point 120 rods West and 6 rods 12 links North of the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section 8 in Township 75 Range 26 West of the 5th P. M. running thence North 19 rods, thence West 18 rods, thence South 19 rods, thence East 18 rods to place of beginning, which land was then, and for many years after, a part of the Guillems farm That to my personal knowledge, said tract of land above described, was never used for religious meeting purposes, nor as the site of a house of worship under the name of Christian Chappel, or any other name; nor was any part thereof used for any such purpose. This affiant states the fact to be, that there was a Christian Chapel house of worship built and used, in that neighborhood, but never on the land above described, which chapel was afterwards moved and a cemetery established with it; after which it burned, and a new church building was erected, and thereafter called Union Chapel, and so called to this day. I have been a resident of the neighborhood mentioned, till within the last two years, and am familiar with its history during

such time, and the statements made above, are from personal familiar knowledge of the facts stated. Further deponent saith not.
