State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, R. O. Mills, of said County and State, on oath say that I am the person who was grantee in a deed of conveyance from W. S. Young dated March 2, 1915, conveying the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the south five (5) acres of the southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section fourteen (14) in township seventy-four (74) north, of range twenty-six (26) west of the Fifth P. M., Iowa, except one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) acre out of the same, the deed of conveyance being recorded in Deed Record 54 of Madison County, Iowa, at Page 505 thereof, in which conveyance it is recited that it is made subject to a mortgage of the German Savings Bank of Davenport, Iowa, for five thousand (5000) dollars. That said mortgage in fact is a mortgage which was originally made to E. E. McCall for five thousand (5000) dollars on said real estate in the year 1913 and which had been transferred by the said E. E. McCall to the said German Savings Bank of Davenport Scott County, Iowa, the assignment of which mortgage to the said German Savings Bank appears of record in Mortgage Record 64 of Madison County, Iowa, at Page 83 thereof, and the mortgage referred to in said deed of conveyance was not a mortgage made originally to the said German Savings Bank.
