State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, Mrs. Mamie P. Compton, of said County and State, on oath say that I was acquainted with M. Peterson to whom Josiah Scott on or about September 17, 1883 conveyed the north half (½) of the southwest quarter (¼) of section fourteen (14) in township seventy-seven (77) north, of range twenty-nine (29) west of the Fifth P. M., Iowa, and that the full name of said M. Peterson was Matthias Peterson; that his wife was commonly known as Batilda Peterson; that said M. Peterson or Matthias Peterson was the same person as Mathes Peterson who died in Madison County, Iowa, about September 3, 1888, and that the Botilde Peterson named in the registry of heirs of said Mathes Peterson was the same person as the Batilda Peterson aforesaid, and that the said Batilda Peterson was the same person as the Anna B. Peterson who died in Madison County, Iowa, February 9, 1896. In other words M. Peterson, Matthias Peterson, and Mathes Peterson was one and the same man, and that the person whose name appears as Batilda Peterson, Botilde Peterson and Anna B. Peterson was one and the same woman, and was his wife.
