State of Iowa Madison County,SS.I,W.S.Cooper,on oath say that I was acquainted with Samuel P.Rollstin and his wife Mary J.Rollstin for many years prior to the death of said Samuel P.Rollstin who died leaving his widow Mary J.Rollstin surviving.That said Samuel P.Rollstin,who was the defendant in a proceeding brought by said Mary J.Rollstin in the Madison County,Iowa,Distirct Court for authority to execute a conveyance relinquishing his interest in the west half (1/2) of the southwest quarter (1/4),and the south one-fourth (1/4) of the southwest quarter (1/4) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of section thirteen (13),and the northeast quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4),and the south one-fourth (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of section fourteen (14),all in town-ship seventy five (75) north,orange twenty-seven (27) west of the Fifth P.M,Iowa,at No. 11034 Equity,was never adjudged insane.
