occurred sometime during the month of March, 1889 at his home in Penn Township, Madison
County, Iowa. The names of all the heirs of Jacob H. Piatt were as follows: Emeline Piatt his
widow, Walter J. Piatt a son, single, George A. Piatt a son and Lewrena J. Piatt his wife, Lula E.
Griswold a daughter and D.M. Griswold her husband. All were of sound mind, past the age of
twenty one at the time they conveyed the Southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Twenty six (26), Township seventy seven (77) North, Range Twenty nine (29) West
