State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, William Brinson, being first duly sworn, do say that I was well and personally acquainted during his life time with the James Gore hereinafter mentioned, and that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish a record of the facts stated herein.

That the James Gore who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed executed by William McDaniel, dated November 13th, 1851 and recorded in Deed Record A page 145 of Madison County, Iowa, which deed conveys the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P. M., and who is also named as grantee in a certain warranty deed executed by A. B. Haun, dated December 23th, 1851, and recorded in Deed Record A page 146 of Madison County, Iowa, and in which deed the said A. B. Haun attempted and intended to convey to the said James Gore the West Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P. M., is

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the same and identical person as the James Goare who with his wife conveyed to James Black by warranty deed the South East ^{Quarter} (1/4) of Section Twenty-eight (28) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P. M., on the 31st day of March, 1856, as is shown by Deed Record D page 597 of Madison County, Iowa.
