I, G.G. Cornelison, of said County and State, on oath say that I at one time owned the east half (1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section thirty four (34), and the west twenty-five (25) acres of the northwest quarter (1/4) of the southwest Quarter (1/4) and the south seventeen and one-half (17 1/2) acres of the southwest quarter (1/4) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of Section thirty-five (35) in township seventy-four (74) north, of range twenty-eight (28), west of the Fifth P.M., Iowa; which I purchased from Albertine Bates and husband on or about August 26th, 1907; that the writing my name as G.G. Cornelison was a mere clerical error, and that the true name of my grantor was Albertine Bates, the writing of her name as Aldertine Bates in the conveyance to her from the Stuart Merchantile Company of said land being a clerical error; the grantee Aldertine Bates being the same person as my grantor Albertine Bates.
