State of Iowa Madison County, SS.I, Sary E.Harris, of said County and State, on oath say that I was acquainted with John H.Johnson who at one time owned the southwest quarter (1/4) of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of section thirty-five (35) in township seventy-four (74) north, of range twenty-eight (28) west of the Fifth P.M, Iowa, and who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, about June 1860; that the said John H.Johnson left surviving his widow Mary A. Johnson who afterwards married one Thomas Runkle, and as his only heirs at law his children Sarah J.Johnson, Martha V.Johnson, and Louisa C.Johnson. That said Mary A.Runkle survived her husband Thomas Runkle and died intestate more than three years ago leaving surviving as her only heir at law her son Frederick C.Runkle. That said Louisa C.Johnson died prior to the death of her mother Mary A.Johnson, leaving her said mother who afterwards became Mary A. Runkle as her only heir at law. That said Sarah J.Johnson afterwards married one Joseph Henry Carter and is yet living. That said Martha V.Johnson afterwards married one L.A.Eldridge, and died leaving the said L.A.Eldridge as her surviving husband, and leaving as her only heir at law her one child Jennie E.Harris. That all of said decedents have been dead for more than three years, and that their estates have all been settled.
