State of Iowa Madison County, SS. I, E.E. McCall, of said County and State, on oath say that I represented M.A. Strows in making a loan to William C. Smith and wife, Sophia M. Smith of eleven hundred (1100) dollars, which was secured by a mortgage dated September 21, 1901, on a tract described as follows: Commencing at a point Ten (10) chains South of the North West corner of the North East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., running thence South to the South West corner of said Quarter Section, thence East along the South line of said Quarter Section thence North 1.75 chains to a ditch, to the South East corner thereof, thence up said ditch North, 45 degrees West, 33.40 chains, thence West to the place of beginning, containing 81.71 acres, more or less; the mortgage appearing of record in Mortgage Record 42 of Madison County, Iowa, at page 151. That the note representing said mortgage became due September 21, 1906, and that at that time I represented M.A. Strows in the extension of said mortgage for a period of five years, and making the same three hundred (300) dollars larger, and that the mortgage given by W.C. Smith and wife, Sophia M. Smith, to M.A. Strows on the same land, dated September 21, 1906, securing the payment of fourteen hundred (1400) dollars, which appears of record in Mortgage Record 49 of Madison County, Iowa, at page 15 thereof, represents the same indebtedness as the said eleven hundred (1100) dollar mortgage before referred to, together with the three hundred (300) dollars additional; and that at the time of the execution of the said fourteen hundred (1400) dollar note and mortgage, the said note and mortgage for eleven hundred (1100) dollars was cancelled and surrendered to said William C. Smith. That I afterwards purchased said fourteen hundred (1400) dollar note and mortgage from George Strows, the executor of the last will of said M.A. Strows, whose estate was administered upon under the name of Mary A. Strows, and that all of said indebtedness has now been paid.
