Rosier, of County and State aforesaid, being duly sworn, upon his oath says, that "I was personally acquainted with John Baptiste Valle of the County and State aforesaid, at the time of his death, and with his family connection, that he died about the year 1849, leaving all his property, real and personal to his 3 sons, as follows One Equal third part to his son Felix Valle, One equal third part to his son Francis B. Valle, One equal third part to the heirs of his son John B. Valle Jr. deceased. John B. Valle Jr. died intestate, and left surviving him the following children, Jules Valle, Zoe Valle wife of Francis C. Rosier, Louise, wife of Felix Rosier and Mary, wife of Finnie A. Rosier, and his widow Palagie Valle, who died intestate about the year 1850. That Francis B. Valle, son of John B. Valle Jr. died testate about the year 1851 leaving a Will in which he devised all his real estate to his children, to-wit: Auoidie Valle, Mirie Valle, John B. Valle, Vital F. Valle, Marie Juliette Valle, Marie Valle, wife of Anthony LaGrave and Marie Clotilda Valle, wife of J. D. Rosier, share and share alike. Felix Valle son of said John B. Valle, Jr. died in the year 1877, leaving a widow who still survives him, he left a will, devising all his property real and personal to his widow and Nephews, and Nieces.
