I, George Strows, of said County and State, on oath say that I am a son of M.A. Strows who was the mortgagee in a certain mortgage for eleven hundred (1100) dollars, dated September 21, 1901, given by William C. Smith and wife, Sophia M. Smith, on the following described real estate, to-wit: Commencing at a point Ten (10) chains South of the North West corner of the North East Quarter (1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the Fifth P.M., running thence South to the South West corner of said Quarter Section, thence East along the South line of said Quarter Section to the South East corner thereof, thence North 1.75 chains to a ditch, thence up said ditch North, 45 degrees West, 33.40 chains, thence West to the place of beginning, containing 81.71 acres, more or less; the mortgage appearing of record in Mortgage Record 42 of Madison County, Iowa, at page 151. That when said mortgage became due there was an additional loan of three hundred (300) dollars made by said M.A. Strows to said William C. Smith and wife, and in evidence of the renewal of the eleven hundred (1100) dollar mortgage and the additional three hundred (300) dollars then loaned, said William C. Smith and wife gave to M.A. Strows on September 21, 1906, a mortgage for fourteen hundred (1400) dollars on the same land, which appears of record in Mortgage Record 49 of said County, at page 15 thereof, and that the full of said eleven hundred (1100) dollars mortgage was included in said fourteen hundred (1400) dollar mortgage. That I also acted as executor of the last will of Mary A. Strows, who was the same person as said M.A. Strows, and that said fourteen hundred (1400) dollar mortgage as sold to E.E. McCall and the amount thereof accounted for in the distribution of the estate.
