I, Edith Males, being first duly sworn, on oath, say, that I am the daughter of Cyrus Walker deceased, and am one of the defendants named in the action of Martha A. Walker versus Joel Wehr, et als, which was a partition action filed August 1, 1916, in the district court of Polk County, Iowa; that I am intimately acquainted with both the plaintiff and with all the defendants in said action and I know that the George Walker, named in said action, and the George A. Walker, named in the registry of heirs on file in Madison County, Iowa, of Cyrus Walker, deceased, are one and the same person. That the Ethel Walker, one of the parties in said partition action, and Ethyl Walker named as one of the heirs in registry of heirs aforesaid is one and the same person. That the Mrs Mae Groves named in said partition action and the Mae Groves named in the aforesaid registry of heirs of Cyrus Walker are one and the same. I further state that the Joel Wehr one of the defendants in the said partition action and the J.C. Wehr, who accepted service of the original notice of said action and the J.A. Wehr who was named in the decree in said action are one and the same person. I further say that I am acquainted with Ethyl E. Walker who was grantee in a deed dated October 7-1902 and I am acquainted with the Ethyl Walker who was grantor in a deed dated June 22, 1903, said deed conveying lots 11 and 12, in Block 1, Nicholson's Addition to Earlham, Iowa, and I state that they are one and the same person. That the Mrs Gertie Wehr named as one of the defendants in said partition action and the Gertie Wehr named in the aforesaid registry of heirs of Cyrus Walker are one and the same person.
