Hill, being first duly affirmed depose and say I have been a continuous resident of Madison County Iowa, for over thirty years and have been personally and well acquainted with Orren Taylor during all this time, and would say he has always gone by the name of Orren Taylor and he never used any initial; that the tax against C.R. Taylor, Madison Township for 1903, amount fifty cents, does not refer to Orren Taylor. I further state Orren Taylor had a tax in Earlham for 1903 of \$5.14 and at that time he lived in the town of Earlham.

Ifurther state I have been personally acquainted with Ed Thompson during all his life time and that he was born in the year 1887, that he never lived in Jefferson Township Madison County, Iowa, but always ^{has} lived in Earlham or Madison Township or Penn Township, Madison County, Iowa; that the tax of Ed Thompson of Jefferson Township Madison County, Iowa for the years 1905 and 1906 does not refer to Ed Thompson one of the heirs of Almeida R. Wroe. I know the exact age of Ed Thompson and Orren Taylor as I was Administrator of their Grandmother, Rebecca Morgan's estate and am also Administrator of the Almeida R. Wroe estate.
