State of Iowa Warren County :SS I, Charles W. Aylward on oath depose and say that I am forty-six years old and have been a resident of Warren County, Iowa, all of said time; that I am a son of Michael Aylward and Mary A. Aylward; that Michael Aylward at the time of his death was the owner of the North Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seven (7) Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-five (25) West, 5th P.M. Iowa, and Lots One (1), Four (4), Five (5) Eight (8) and Nine (9) Block Three (3) Callison's Addition to Cumming, Warren County, Iowa, and Lots Three (3) Four (4) Thirty (30). Thirty one (31) and Thirty-two (32) Nuttals Addition to the town of Valley Junction, Polk County, Iowa, and the South Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twelve (12) Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West, 5th P.M.
