

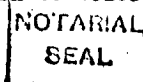

State of Iowa; Madison County :SS I, Chauncey S. Miller, of Madison County, Iowa, on oath say that I am a son of Mary Jane Miller, who died on or about August 4, 1902, owning lots five (5) and six (6) in Block three (3) of Railroad Addition to Winterset, Iowa; that my father, Brice S. Miller, died intestate on August 15, 1908; that he was the same person whose estate was administered upon in Madison County, Iowa, the name appearing sometimes as Brice S. Miller and sometimes as Benjamin S. Miller; and that Benjamin S. Miller was his correct name his nick name being Brice S. Miller.

I further state that I took possession of said property upon the death of my father; that I paid all of the legacies provided for in the last will and testament of my mother and the codicil thereto; and that none of the children or heirs at law of Mary Jane Miller or Brice S. Miller, or any of their descendants, ever made or asserted any claim to said real estate or any part thereof, except their right to the legacies provided for by the will of Mary Jane Miller; and that since the payment of such legacies, none of them have made or asserted any right, title or interest of any kind or character whatever.
