State of Iowa Madison County, SS;- I,R.E.Cameron, aresident of said County and State being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am a son of James R.Cameron, who died to testate in Holmes County, Ohio about the month of October A.D. 1895, seized of the West Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the East Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-three (23) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 6th P.M.; that my mother, Mary Ann Cameron, wife of the said James R.Cameron, survived the said James R.
