McClintoc mentioned in a sheriff's deed of said land, Dated July 19th, 1881, conveying said land to H.W.Munger as surviving partner of the firm of White & Munger, and the same and identical person as the John E. McClintoc against whom judgment was entered in Madison County in favor of said firm of White & Munger, which firm was to me well known.

That I have been a resident of Madison County Iowa, for 55 years last past, and make the foregoing statement from my knowledge of the facts stated, and am in no way interested, and that the entry of the name of the said John E. McClintoc in the said records as McClintoc was a clerical error, and referred to and was in fact the John E. McClintoc first herein above described. Further deponent saith not.
