State of Iowa Madison County SS; I, W.F.Craig a resident of said county and state, being duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I was Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, from January 1909, until January 1913, and that during my administration in said office the estate of Henry J.B.Cummings late, of said county, deceased, was probated; that my attention has been called to the omission in the record of the proceedings in said estate, of any record of the order to give notice of appointment which I, as Clerk directed Laura J. Miller, as exec utrix of the last will and testament of said decedent, to give of her appointment as such; that such omission from the record occurred by reason of following a precedent established by former Clerks in said office, but I know and state it to be a fact, that the notice of appointment which said executrix did in fact give was the notice which she was, by me directed to give and that such direction and order for notice of appointment was endorsed upon the commission or certificate of appointment which was issued to her, which was the usual and regular custom and practice of the office at that time.
