Whereas Andrew Robison of Winterset, Iowa, in said district, has been duly adjudged a bankrupt, under the Acts of Congress relating to bankruptcy, and appears to have conformed to all the requirements of the law in that behalf, upon motion of John A. & W.T. Guier attorneys for said bankrupt, it is therefore ordered by this court that said Andrew Robison be discharged from all debts and claims, which are made provable by said acts against his estate, and which existed on the 6th day of November A.D. 1916, on which day the petition for adjudication was filed by him, excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a discharge in bankruptcy.
