State of Iowa Madison County SS I, Laura L. Benson, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say, that I am a daughter of J.S. Lorimer, who was a brother of H.J. Lorimer, and as such daughter, am well acquainted with the different members of the Lorimer family and with the matters and things hereinafter stated; and that I well know that H.J. Lorimer died intestate in the state of Ohio in the year A.D. 1859, and that he was never married. That his mother, Sarah Chambers Lorimer, died Sept 26th, 1846, and his father, Alexander Lorimer died November 15th 1874, intestate. After the death of the said Sarah Chambers Lorimer, the said Alexander Lorimer again married, leaving surviving him at his death, his second wife, Jane Lorimer, and his only son and child by said second marriage, Joseph B. Lorimer.

That John Lorimer, A.C. Lorimer, J.S. Lorimer, A.W. Lorimer and B.F. Lorimer were brothers of the said H.J. Lorimer deceased, and that Margaret C. McConnell, S. McKnight, Amanda C. Lorimer, Martha A. Roe were sisters of the said H.J. Lorimer deceased, and all of whom were children of the said Alexander Lorimer and his first wife Sarah Chambers Lorimer.

That on February 18th, 1876, the date of the filing of a conveyance of North Half of North West Quarter of Section Ten in Township Seventy-four North, of Range Twenty-seven West of 5th P.M. as shown by the records of Madison County, Iowa, Lib Lorimer was the wife of the grantor John Lorimer, Margaret C. McConnell was a widow, J.B. McKnight was the husband of the grantor S. McKnight, Amanda C. Lorimer was unmarried, Joseph Roe was the husband of grantor Martha A. Roe, Lizzie B. Lorimer was the wife of the grantor A.C. Lorimer, B.A. Lorimer was the wife of the grantor J.S. Lorimer, M.J. Lorimer was the wife of the grantor A.W. Lorimer and Mary E. Lorimer was the wife of the grantor B.F. Lorimer.

That the said Jane Lorimer, the second wife of the said Alexander Lorimer deceased, died intestate in the year 1884, and that her only son and heir at law, was the said Joseph B. Lorimer. That the Josiah Larimer to whom a patent was issued by The United States government for the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Ten, Township Seventy-four North, Range Twenty-seven was the same and identical person as Josiah S. Lorimer, who, his wife joining, conveyed said land to Benjamin F. Lorimer, by deed dated June 22nd 1855 as shown by the records of Madison County, Iowa; and that the said grantee, Benjamin F. Lorimer who was also the patentee of the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of said Section Ten, was the same and identical person as B.F. Lorimer, who, his wife joining, conveyed part of said land to John Lorimer by deed dated April 14th 1857, and the other part under the name of B.F. Larimer, his wife joining, by deed dated November 12th, 1855, to John Larimer, and that he is the same and identical person as the B.F. Lorimer, who, with his wife Mary E. joined with others in the execution of a conveyance for all of said land to A.W. Lorimer, filed for record February 18th, 1876, as shown by the records of Madison County, Iowa.

That the said John Lorimer, grantee as aforesaid, and John Larimer, grantee as aforesaid, and John Larimer, who with his wife, Lib executed a deed of said land to said H.J. Larimer, dated July 11th, 1857 as shown by the records of Madison County Iowa refer to and are, one and the same identical person.

That the A.W. Lorimer, who with his wife Martha J. Lorimer, conveyed said land to Josiah S. Lorimer by deed dated February 18th, 1876, is identical with the A.W. Lorimer who was the grantee in said conveyance thereof hereinbefore mentioned, and that said grantee Josiah S. Lorimer was the same and identical person as the J.S. Lorimer, who, his wife joining, conveyed said land to J.H. Creger by deed dated October 7th, 1890, as shown by the records of Madison County Iowa.

That said persons named herein, with said Joseph B. Lorimer, were the only surviving children of said Alexander Lorimer, no other children and no issue of any deceased child or children having survived him; and being the persons of same initials and given names sometimes

referred to, as Larimor, Lorimer, Lorimor, and Larimer.

That this affiant is in no way interested in the subject matter or title to the land affected by the foregoing statements of facts, but makes the same at the request of Lincoln Harbold, for the sole purpose of explaining and correcting record errors and discrepancies in the record title thereto, as indicated hereby, to the end that the same may be placed of record.
