I, E.E.McCall, of said state and county being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say, that I had some business dealings with Wyllys King, about twelve years since; that at that time he was a resident of St Louis; that in the course of said dealings (being a sale of land in Madison county, Iowa) I learned that he was the same Wyllys King who was a member of the firm of Doan King & Co, and as such, became connected with the Martha Bigelow estate, said estate having an interest in said firm of Doan King & Co, and the same matter coming up in title to said land sold for said King. From the information gained in said transaction, I am well satisfied that Willis King, the grantee in a deed from H.J.B.Cummings and M.L.McPherson and wives dated Feb'y 8th, 1859, is the same and identical person as Wyllys King who conveyed the land acquired under the said deed to Martha Bigelow.
