I, Catherine Christina Acker, on oath say that I am a daughter of Nicholas Schoenenberger who at one time owned the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section seven (7) in township seventy-four (74) north, of range twenty seven (27) west of the Fifth P.M. Iowa, and that he is the same and identical man as the Nicholas Shannenberger as the name appears in the original entries of a part of said land, as shown by the book of original entries of Madison County, Iowa. That Louisa Schoenenberger who executed on or about January 26, 1903 a quit claim deed conveying said land to Louisa Angeline Wilson, Catherine Christina Acker, Ida Theresa Boling, and Minnie Rollstin, was my mother and was the same and identical person as Mary Louisa Schoenenberger named in the last will and testament of said Nicholas Schoenenberger. That the said Louisa Angeline Wilson, Catherine Christina Acker, and Ida Theresa Boling, grantees in said quit claim deed, are the same and identical persons as Lou Wilson, Christena Acker, and Ida T. Boling named in the registry of heirs in the estate of said Nicholas Schoenenberger and that Minnie Rollstin, the grantor in a quit claim dated June 8, 1911 to the said Louisa Angeline Wilson, Catherine Christina Acker, and Ida Theresa Boling, was the same and identical person as Minnie Florence Rollstin named as devisee in the codicil to the last will and testament of said Nicholas Schoenenberger. That all of the above stated facts are true as I believe. Catherine Christina Acker.
