State of Iowa, Madison County, SS, I, Seth Brittain, being first duly sworn, depose and say as follows: That I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and a son of the Alfred Brittain and Julia Brittain who are named in a certain petition for the sale of real estate, filed by myself and David Brittain as executors of the last will and testament of Alfred Brittain, deceased, in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on June 20th, 1914, as is shown by Probate Docket F page 335 of said county.

That my mother, the said Julia Brittain, died intestate and unmarried in Madison County, Iowa, on the 16th day of February, A.D. 1914, leaving no adopted children and leaving as her only heirs at law, her children, David Brittain, Seth Brittain, Pleasant Brittain, Martha Guiberson, John Brittain, Robert Brittain, Maria Ringgenberg, and William Brittain, and her grandchild, Susan Bond, and she left no other children and no other issue of a deceased child.

That the said Maria Ringgenberg who is named as a daughter of the said Alfred Brittain in the registry of his heirs is the same person as the Maria Ringgenberger named in the will of the said Alfred Brittain and in the above described petition to sell real estate and in the original notice of said petition, and that the Martha Guiberson named in said will and in said petition and notice thereof is the same person as the M. J. Guiberson named in said registry of heirs.
